Purpose of Policy:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the Boards requirements for the addition of an endorsement on a registration.

Policy:

A practitioner in the sub-category Certifying Plumber and Drainer (Design) may apply for an endorsement on their registration to include the design of fire hydrants, hose reels and/or commercial and residential fire sprinkler systems. The application is made in the form of a letter to the Board requesting the endorsement along with a resume, copy of relevant qualifications and references.

In order for the Board to approve the endorsement the practitioner must have appropriate qualifications and demonstrate experience in the design of the relevant appliances and systems.

Experience – The practitioner must demonstrate at least 3 years experience in the design of the relevant appliances and systems. A reference from at least one hydraulic engineer (preferably registered in the Northern Territory) or some other person who in the opinion of the Board has recognised experience in the field.

Qualifications for fire hydrants and hose reels, the practitioner must have successfully completed the qualification units CPCSFS5007A Create detailed designs for hydrant and hose reel systems (without pumps) and CPCPPS5030A Design pump systems (with pumps), Qualifications for the design of residential and domestic fire sprinkler systems - the practitioner must have successfully completed the qualification units CPCPFS4024A Design residential and domestic fire sprinkler systems and the additional CPCPFS5011A Design fire sprinkler systems, or units that, in the opinion of the Board, is at least equivalent to these units.
